## **Introduction to Coordinating a Concert!**

**Goal:** *To glorify God, to open hearts to God's presence in everyday life, to build community by coming together to share prayer, song and story.*

- **Where:** Your church sanctuary, a prayerful environment to sing and pray.
- **When:** Thursday or Friday evening 7:00-8:30 (Saturday and Sunday are family times for Good for the Soul artists)
- **Who:**
  - You:** A local parish "team" joyfully prepares the community for this event.
    - **Concert Captain** – coordinates, gathers team, communicates between Good For The Soul Music and the parish.
    - **Promotion Leaders** – coordinate advertising to "fill God's house" that evening.
    - **Choir Leader** – coordinates local choir participation in concert.
    - **Volunteer Leader** – coordinates volunteers for doors, sales tables, and taking the offering.
    - **Technical Leader** – coordinates all sound / instrument aspects.
    - **Journaling Workshop Coordinator** – helps facilitate the morning-after ministry workshop, led by David Kauffman.

**Us:** The Good For The Soul Music team, David Kauffman and sometimes other musical artists, like William Gokelman, composer, arranger, co-writer; or artists Sergio Tamez, Kate Portele and Justin Graves.

**God:** Whose grace covers all our efforts and who gifts us with His presence in our every moment!

- **How:**
    - A – Support** - Talk to your pastor and your choir director. Choose three possible dates for your concert, and then contact us. We check the schedule here, and do everything we can to accommodate your first choice. Then we send you your **Concert Binder**, and we are ready to start. We stay with you for the whole journey, by phone (210-733-5003 or 800-758-5805) or email [cindy@goodforthesoulmusic.com](mailto:cindy@goodforthesoulmusic.com) answering every question and supplying all you need.
    - B – Plan** - You gather the team, pray, and let God help you bless your community with a Good For The Soul Music Concert! Twelve weeks is the ideal amount of time you will need. However, if your team is Spirit-filled and ready to fill God's house, then it can happen in less time! Our goal is 500 people per concert, and we have loads of ideas to help you make it happen.
    - C – Finances** - We ask for travel and lodging expenses. Merchandise (CDs, books, journals, etc) will be available for sale in your gathering space as well. Because there are no tickets sold and **no charge** to attend, we have two plans for covering our expenses:
      - A) We ask the church for an \$1850 stipend to help cover the costs of coordinating the performance, half due with a signed contract that reserves the date, the other half sent to our office one week before the concert.
- OR**
- B) If the church is willing to allow us to pass baskets for a free will love offering at the end of the concert, we ask for a **\$1000 stipend**. Half the stipend is due with a signed contract that reserves the date, the other half is sent to our office one week before the concert.

The stipend for the Journal Workshop is waived if booked in conjunction with a concert.
